Goals

District Goals: The Board of Education sets goals for the entire district.

ELA

- at least 60.3% of SCS students in 3rd grade will score On Track or Mastered on the TNReady ELA assessment.
- at least 57.6% of SCS students in 4th and 5th grade will score On Track or Mastered on the TNReady ELA assessment.

Math

- at least 58.8% of SCS students in 3rd - 5th grade will score On Track or Mastered on the TNReady math assessment.

School Goals: BBE administrators, school leaders, & teachers use student achievement data to determine the most important areas for improvement for our school.

ELA By spring of 2025, Benny Bills Elementary will increase the percentage of 3rd-5th grade students scoring on-track or mastered on the ELA portion of the TNReady assessment from 24.2% to \geq 33.7%.

Math By spring of 2025, Benny Bills Elementary will increase the percentage of 3rd-5th grade students scoring on-track or mastered on the Math portion of the TNReady assessment from 22.2% to \geq 31.9%.
